

Cybot Galactica AP2 Administrative Droid

**Classification:** medium third-degree administrative droid

**Cost:** 4,750

**Availability:** Prevalent

**Era:** *Future of the Galaxy* era only

Since the release of Industrial Automaton's new R8 series astromech droid, Cybot Galactica has felt that an updated protocol droid was in order to capitalize on the new "more power" droid market. Learning from its previous models, and incorporating a far higher quality of design and construction, the AP2 administrative-protocol droid was released.

Internally, the AP2 is very similar to the LE series droids, and most parts from either droid are interchangeable. The AP2 has a heavier outer casing, however, to remove the "skeletal" appearance some describe the LE series droids of having, and to make the AP2 a better fit for its designed functions. As well, the outer casing is plasteel, giving the AP2 a more glossy, appealing look, while rendering the AP2 not nearly so prone to corrosion as the 3PO model. Even the head has a similar appearance to the LE series, though the holo-recorder is mounted along side the normal photoreceptor, giving a more humanoid facial appearance.

The AP2 was also given an AA-2 Verboobrain, an updated model to that of the 3PO series. An AP2 is even more intelligent than a 3PO droid, is just as capable at lingual translation, and has no trace of the prissiness legendary among the older protocol models. Instead, the AP2 is slightly more taciturn (a welcome change from the 3PO series), polite, observant, subtle, and discrete. Typically, an AP2 will gravitate to one specific master, and relate information most readily to that individual. While still perfectly helpful to anyone else the droid is subservient to, the AP2 will only reveal greater details or more privileged information to that chosen master, unless otherwise instructed by that individual. Finally, the designers of the AP2 decided to incorporate slightly more customizability into the droid, borrowing a bit from Industrial Automaton's philosophy. IA has actually been quoted as being pleased with this decision, citing that the few AP2 models that have been brought in for servicing at IA-sponsored droid repair facilities find the droid far easier to modify or repair.
